When we shared this with her, she confessed that she had planned to commit suicide this winter, but for some reason her friend refused to leave her alone during that time, denying her the opportunity to act on her plans. We know this was an answer to our prayers, and now she does as well!

She reached out to me a few days after prayer night to tell us what a positive impact it had on her life. She said she left feeling good about herself for the first time in a long

time! She told me that she was planning to come twice a month. This is a huge commitment for her since she lives 45 minutes away and has a number of health problems making travel difficult.

Unfortunately life is not always easy. The vehicle that we sold Kim ended up having major engine failure about 3000 miles after we sold it to her. At first, she was a mess. She struggled to understand why the freedom she had just managed to get back was gone already. We were disappointed and frustrated as well.

We decided to refund the money she had given us for the vehicle, help her get the vehicle to her home, and advised her to sell it for parts to recoup the cost of transferring title, insurance, etc.

We recently heard that she was able to sell the vehicle and actually came out slightly ahead financially. She was also able to purchase another vehicle at a reasonable

price. She is so excited to be able to join us again for prayer nights now that she has another vehicle!

Looking back, this was not only a huge opportunity to build our relationship with her even more, but it was also a tremendous opportunity to show her more of Christ's love. We can honestly say that we are glad things worked out the way that they did. God's plan may not make sense to us while it is happening, but He is always looking out for what is truly best for us. Not what we think is best for us, but what is truly best for us.
